

# Among us toy knitting pattern



## Overview

The pattern is intended for beginner users. The basic yarn for knitting Among us toy is shown in the pattern; also you can use suitable analogs.

The used techniques are shown in the «**Techniques**» section, and the terms are shown in the «**Abbreviations**» section (at the end of the pattern).

Working is divided into stages:

1. Knitting head and body with legs;
2. Knitting and sewing backpack;
3. Knitting and sewing glass on the face;
4. Glass decoration with embroidery.

## Materials and Tools

1. You can use any suitable wool/cotton yarn with similar footage and properties. I used Kartopu Amigurumi 1.76 Oz (50g) / 142 Yrds (130m), 49% Cotton, 51% Acrylic. The following yarn is also suitable:
  - Yarn art Jeans 1.76 Oz. (50g) / 174 yds (160 m)
  - Alize Cotton Gold 3.53 Oz (100 g) / 361 yds (330 m)
  - Gazzal Baby Cotton 1.76 Oz (50g) / 150 yds (165m), etc.

For one Among us toy, you will need about 0,5Oz (15 grams) of basic yarn and little yarn for Among us glass; Also you need some yarn for embroidery in 2 colors: white and black;

2. Circular needles with long line (from 23.6" (60cm)) for round knitting, or Addi Crazy Trio needles, or double pointed needles. I used US 2 (2,75mm) size needles. Select a knitting needle size based on the specified knitting gauge and your yarn: from US 0 (1,75mm) to US 2 (3,0mm).
3. Toy stuffing (holofiber, thinsulate etc.);
4. Scissors, pins, tapestry needle;
5. 1 knitting marker.

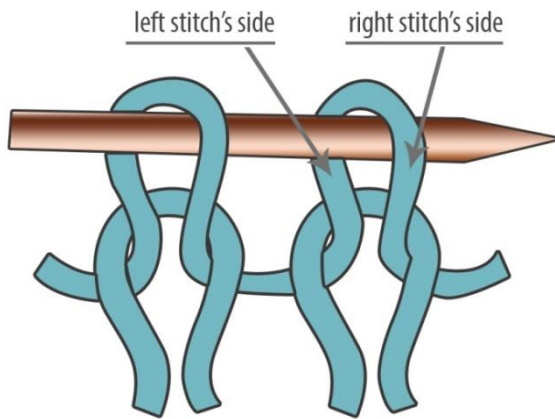


### Gauge

6,5 stitches and 9 rows on a 1x 1" (2,5 x 2,5 cm) swatch in a stockinet stitch with US 2 needles (2,75mm).

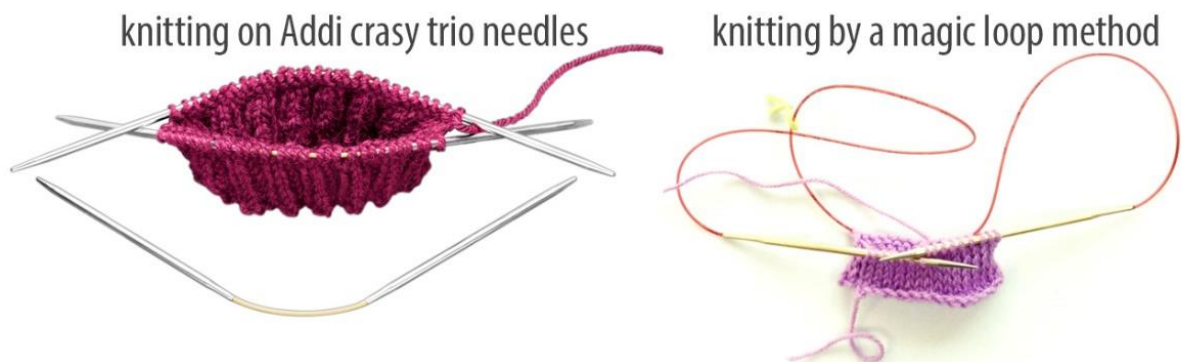
From the specified yarn and gauge, size of the Among us toy is  $3 \frac{1}{3} \times 2 \frac{1}{6}$ " (8,7 x 5,5 cm from bottom to top). For other yarns, the size of the finished toy may vary.

## Pattern



You can use a method of knitting convenient for you. Please take into attention the position of the stitches' sides on the needle, which is shown in the figure: the right side of the stitch should be in front of the knitting needle, the left side of the stitch should be behind the knitting needle. The instructions in this pattern are intended for this stitch's sides position on the needle.

**Note:** in the pattern I am guided by circle knitting on knitting needles with a long line using the magic loop method (or on the Addi crazy trio knitting needles), and the total number of stitches are divided equally and located on two knitting needles, opposite each other. You can use any knitting needles that are convenient for you, taking into account the above.

### 1. Knitting head and body with legs (in a circle, basic color)

Using Judy's magic cast-on (see Techniques unit) on **US 2 (2.75mm)** needles (or your size needles according gauge), cast on **10 stitches**. Distribute the stitches so that there are **5 stitches** on each of the knitting needles. Hide tail in the head of the toy. See video <https://youtu.be/t4XaTgA-orE>

**1 row** — knit all stitches (10 stitches altogether). Set **START marker** of the row.

**2 row (increases)** — **\*(KFB twice, k1, KFB twice)\*** repeat twice to the end of row (8 stitches added, 18 stitches altogether).

**3 row** — knit all stitches (18 stitches altogether).

**4 row (increases)** — **\*(KFB repeat 3 times, k3, KFB repeat 3 times)\*** repeat twice to the end of row (12 stitches added, 30 stitches altogether).

**5-24 rows** — knit all stitches (30 stitches altogether).

Now we will divide knitting into parts: separate stitches for one leg and knit it. Transfer other stitches for the second leg to the waste thread. See video <https://youtu.be/Y22rT7uvhuU>  
**So, we are at the START marker, knit 9 stitches, move 13 stitches to the waste thread, knit 8 stitches** (17 stitches altogether for one leg, 13 stitches are on the waste thread).



### First leg (17 stitches)

**1-7 rows** — knit all stitches (17 stitches altogether).

Stuff the toy's head, body and leg with filler. Next, we will make decreases:

**8 row (decreases)** — **\*(k1, k2tog)\*** repeat to the last 2 stitches, k2 (5 stitches decreased, 12 stitches altogether).

**9 row (decreases)** — **\*(k2tog)\*** repeat to the end of row (6 stitches decreased, 6 stitches altogether).

Stuff the toy's leg with filler, if necessary.

Cut off the yarn, thread the needle and collect all stitches, pull off, hide tail in the toy's leg. First leg is ready, and then we knit second leg.



### Second leg (13 stitches from waste thread + 4 stitches pick up, 17 stitches altogether)

Transfer 13 stitches from the waste thread to the needles (I distribute like this: 7 stitches on first needle, 6 stitches on the second needle), also pick up 2 stitches on each side at the

attachment point of the second leg (4 stitches in total, shown in the Figures). 17 stitches on the needles altogether.



Attach a working thread at a point between the legs, set a marker, and then knit as below:

**1 row** – knit 2 stitches as a twisted stitches, knit to the last 2 stitches, knit 2 stitches as a twisted stitches (17 stitches altogether). See video <https://youtu.be/HuFp8Kvt8hg>  
**2-7 rows** — knit all stitches (17 stitches altogether).

Stuff second leg with filler. Next, we will make decreases:

**8 row (decreases)** — \*(k1, k2tog)\* repeat to the last 2 stitches, k2 (5 stitches decreased, 12 stitches altogether).

**9 row (decreases)** — \*(k2tog)\* repeat to the end of row (6 stitches decreased, 6 stitches altogether).

Stuff the toy's leg with filler, if necessary.

Cut off the yarn, thread the needle and collect all stitches, pull off, hide tail in the toy's leg. Next we will knit backpack.



## 2. Knitting and sewing backpack (2 parts, sewing to the base)

Using «Long tail cast on method» (see Techniques unit) cast **10 stitches** on the **US 2 (2.75mm)** needle (or your size). Leave tail of the thread for sewing to the body.

**1-13 rows** — knit all stitches (10 stitches altogether).

Bind off stitches, cut off the yarn. Make other part of backpack in the same way, 2 parts altogether.

Sew two parts of the backpack together around the perimeter; fill inside of the backpack with filler before final sewing. See video <https://youtu.be/KOkvid5tSxc>



Pin the finished backpack to the body with pins, sew with a needle with thread that we left for sewing. See video <https://youtu.be/pFJ00TPFmE0>



### 3. Knitting and sewing glass on the face (1 part, sewing to the base)

Using «Long tail cast on method» cast 10 stitches on the US 2 (2.75mm) needle (or your size). Leave tail of the thread for sewing to the face.

**1 row (increases, Right side (RS))** — KFB, k8, KFB (2 stitches added, 12 stitches altogether).

**2 row (Wrong side (WS))** — purl all stitches (12 stitches altogether).

**3 row (RS)** — knit all stitches (12 stitches altogether).

**4 row (WS)** — purl all stitches (12 stitches altogether).

**5 row (RS)** — knit all stitches (12 stitches altogether).

**6 row (WS)** — purl all stitches (12 stitches altogether).

**7 row (decreases, RS)** — k2tog, k8, kztog (2 stitches decreased, 10 stitches altogether).

Bind off stitches as knit wise, leave the tail for sewing. Pin the finished glass to the face with pins; using «Mattress stitch seam» (see Techniques unit) sew with thread that we left for

sewing. Fill inside of the glass with filler before final sewing. See video

#### 4. Glass decoration with embroidery

Now we will make the edge of the glass in black color with «Back stitch» technique. See video

Embroider glitter on the glass with white thread (I use yarn, sewing thread can also be used).

Hide all the tails from the thread into the body. Carry out wet-heat treatment according to «Care» unit.

**CARE** - Hand wash with delicate laundry detergents (for angora, wool, silk, cashmere, cotton, hand-wash), at 30°C/90F Max. No bleaching. No tumble dry. Do not squeeze after washing. Lay flat to dry.

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### Abbreviations

<b>START</b>	start of row marker, indicates the location of the beginning of the knitting row.
<b>k</b>	knit stitch. For example k3 mean – «knit 3 stitches»
<b>p</b>	purl stitch. For example p3 mean – «purl 3 stitches»
<b>*( )*</b>	repeat the action in brackets according to the instructions. For example: <i>*(k1, k2tog)* repeat to end of row</i> mean — repeat knit actions: «1 knit stitch, decreasing two stitches with a tilt to the right » so many times, until we reach the end of the row.

**KFB** (*knit front behind*) — knit into the front and back of the stitch. Increase. Knit into the stitch and before slipping it off the left needle, twist the right needle behind the left and knit the same stitch again through the back loop. Slide the original stitch off the left needle — there are now 2 stitches on the right needle made from the original one. See video <https://youtu.be/xMJCIQR17TA>



**k2tog** (*knit 2 together*) — knit two stitches together to the right. Decrease. To knit 2 stitches together, just insert the right needle into two stitches at the same time and knit. This will result in a decrease of one stitch. This decrease will slant to the right. See video [https://youtu.be/3V62nIBlg\\_w](https://youtu.be/3V62nIBlg_w)



### Techniques

Judy's magic cast on — an invisible cast-on for anything where you are knitting in the round and need a neat, seamless edge. It's invisible on both sides of the fabric and it is also quick and easy. This cast-on was first devised by Judy Becker. See video <https://youtu.be/t4XaTgA-orE>

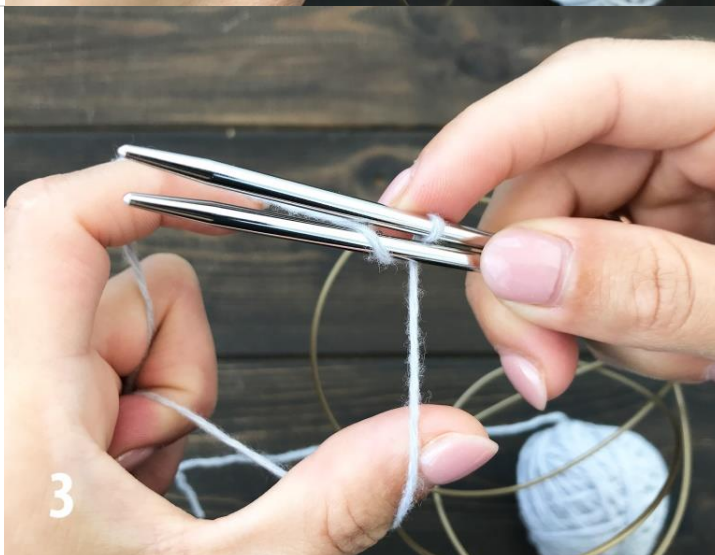
**1 step:** Hold the needle with the tips parallel in the right hand. Put the working thread on the **far** knitting needle so that the thread from the skein is located **away from you**, and the free tail of the thread is **towards you**.



**2 step:** cross the threads under the knitting needles in a counterclockwise motion and form the first stitch. To do this, take the free tail of the thread **away from you** and place it on the **index finger**, bring the thread from the skein **to you** and place it on your **thumb**.



**3 step:** with a movement away from you, wrap the **lower (nearest) knitting needle** with the thread located on the **index finger**, forming a stitch.



**4 step:** with a movement away from you, wrap the **far (upper) knitting needle** with the thread located on the **thumb**, forming a stitch.



**5 step:** repeat steps 3 and 4 to set the desired number of stitches.



**6 step:** turn the knitting clockwise and put knitting needles in your left hand. Pull out the bottom knitting needle and start knitting.



**Collect all stitches** —technique, using which we collect all «live» stitches on a working thread. Used to closed round or sharp tops. See video <https://youtu.be/35-w-kYdL20>

**Long tail cast on method** — this easy cast on in knitting creates a stretchy edge which is necessary to your project. See video [https://youtu.be/V3sH\\_oJagoc](https://youtu.be/V3sH_oJagoc)

**Bind off stitches** — this method is the most commonly known and used for knitters. It is also easy to learn and makes a neat, tidy edge. See video <https://youtu.be/7lxqXBeRlz8>

**Mattress stitch seam (variation for this pattern)** —performed by alternately sewing two sides of stitch (left and right sides) at once from each of the stitched parts. If it is impossible to sew the sides of the loop, the bar between the loops is captured. See video <https://youtu.be/xGeNGSng1DQ>

**Step 1:** Grab with the needle two sides of the stitch from the first part (for example, this is head of rabbit).



**Step 2:** Grab with the needle two sides of the stitch from the second part (for example, this is ear of rabbit). Alternating steps 1 and 2 sew the parts along the intended contour. After the end of the seam, fasten the thread securely and hide it in the fabric.
